CIF GENERAL INFORMATION

- Player Ejection (See CIF/SS handout)

ASSIGNMENTS

- Confirm your assignment with school AD the day before or the morning of the contest.
- Confirm date, time and site. (Get Coach's contact for Saturdays)
- If a school changes a game with you, notify the Assignor of the change

INCLEMENT WEATHER (FIRE, SMOKE, FLOOD, EARTHQUAKES ETC.) (see CIF/SS handout)

- Call the school by 1:00 P.M. to confirm.
- Talk to someone in authority and know who you talked to.
- If it is still undecided about the contest being played, set a time to check back.
- If they tell you to come and the game is cancelled, you receive ½ game fee.

OFFICIALS CONDUCT

- Be on time
- Proper uniform
- Professional attitude
- Don't fraternize with coaches, players or spectators

- Maintain a positive demeanor
- Do not linger after the contest

GAME FEES, TRAVEL FEES

- Varsity (3-7 Off) \$148 Non Varsity (3-7 Off) \$99
- Flag Football Varsity 3 OFF \$74, 2 OFF \$81 Non-Varsity 3 OFF \$58, 2 OFF \$64
 - Round Trip Mileage
 - 51-75 = \$18, 76-125=\$31, 126-175=\$44,
176-250=\$62, 251-350=\$88, 351-450=\$123
- Travel Fees
 - (Regular Season) Origination point is the official's residence. If official resides outside the assignment area, origination point is where the official enters the assignment area. Each official that drives to the contest is entitled to mileage reimbursement during the regular season. (Playoffs) Origination point is the meeting place of the officials association. Only one travel is paid per contest. The lead official receives the travel reimbursement during the playoffs
 - Length of Quarters.

The length of the quarters in football games shall be twelve (12) minutes at the Varsity, Junior Varsity, Freshman levels. Time may be shortened only by mutual consent of both competing schools. At the conclusion of the third quarter or any point thereafter, if there is a point differential of 35 or more points, a running clock shall be instituted for the remainder of the game regardless of the score. The clock will stop only for a score, free kick, charged team timeout.
 - Tie Breaker System. Authorized for use in the CIF/SS playoff as follows,

respective leagues have the option of adopting the plan for use. If adopted, then all ties must be resolved with the "25 – yard Tie Breaker System" and may be used for JV and Freshman levels. Mutual Consent may be used for non-league contests.
